"John Bailies [Baylie, Bailly], the first signer of the  
petition of 1664, was, probably, the same who had resided  
at Guilford, Ct., in 1642. A John Bailly was  
admitted a freeman of Ct., May 21, 1657, and was  
chosen constable at Hartford March 16, 16547.  
This may have been his son. Previous to 1662,  
he had removed to Jamaica, L. I., where he was  
familiarily called "Goodman Baylie," and was  
licensed to keep an Ordinary for the town.  
He was one of the four patentees of this  
town, but, probably, did not become a resident,  
as he disposed of his interest here, Sept 9, 1665,  
to Gov. Carteret, for "a valuable sum." He was  
still living at Jamaica in 1663."
