Will of William B. Michener of Pennsylvania
July 21 1846 July 10 1847

"reposing confidence in my one opinion and in no other
opinion or in any being Superior to man for I know of
none nor do I believe in any other that I am responsible
to being concies that after I am gone that the orthodox
will continue there houlng about my opinion as
heretofore as well also they have done about recan-
lations about which money faults storys has got into
circulation I will instance one on Thomas Paine
of which there is abundant profe is faults of which
any one may satisfy himself by reading his life
that the foregoing lines are correct"
