

Fort Pitt. Jan. 15. 1860

My dear Papa

I left Pondwell yesterday
at 9 a. m., reached London
at 1.15., drove off to Oxford
St. and got a hat at a
Townends, but not our Town-
-ends, however I dare say
it will do just as well.

I then drove back to
London Bridge Termi-
-nus and caught the
2.20 train, which brought
me in here at about 4.
I found uncle Joe on

the platform at Stood,
and drove up here with
him. He advises me
not to sleep in London
but to leave this tomorrow
afternoon (Monday) and
proceed by the night mail
which leaves Euston Square
at 9. p.m. and ought
to arrive at Kingstown
about 10 a.m. on Tuesday
morning. This I intend
to do, as it will save
much cost and trouble.

I shall leave my measure
at Jones & Harrison's
en passant. I suppose

I shall find you at Kings-
-town on Tuesday morning
that is, if this letter ar-
-rives in time.
