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## ANOTHER WELLS BIBLE

This Bible Record was sent by the owner, William H. Wells of Portland, Oregon, encouraged by H. Jack Wells, who had sent the earlier WELLS Bible Record (vol 9, no 2, p 43). The Bible was printed in Oxford, England in 1739 by John Baskett, printer to the University, and has come down through the family. Some abbreviations have been made for editorial convenience. Each page (number in parentheses) is in two columns, but is shown as one. Some line of demarkation, such as —•—, was made after each entry, but is not reproduced here. Each page is headed:
