INTRODUCTION

George Jacob Martz was born on August 27, 1822, near Frederick, Maryland. His early years were spent here with his family, until he entered Gettysburg College(PA), where he received his A.B. in 1846. Upon graduation from the college, Martz entered Gettysburg Seminary and graduated from here in 1848. During the same year, he was ordained in the Maryland Synod of the Lutheran Church of America.

Rev. Martz choose to begin his ministry by first doing missionary work in India(1849-52). When his missionary tour was completed he returned to his native state and served as pastor of the Lutheran Church in Sharpsburg, MD(1852-56). In 1855/56 he moved to Dauphin County, PA, where he served as pastor to churches in the charge comprising Sheep's, Swatara, Dauphin, Sandy Hollow and Wenrich's. He married during his pastorate here, to Caroline Nunemaker, on December 3, 1857. Rev. Martz left Dauphin County in 1867/68 and moved to Womelsdorf, PA, where he became pastor of the local Lutheran Church. Womelsdorf is situated on the western edge of Berks County, midway between the cities of Lebanon and Reading. During his pastorate here, the Lutheran Church in PA was going through some organizational and theological changes. The south eastern section of Lebanon County(Womelsdorf is directly east) including Myerstown, Richland, Schaefferstown, Kleinfeltersville, and a small area of northern Lancaster County were caught up in the sometimes heated controversies going on at the time. While various new church charges were being organized, disolved and reorganized and numerous ministers coming into and leaving the area, Rev. Martz, from his resident church in Womelsdorf, ministered to the needs of many in the Lebanon/Lancaster areas mentioned above. It is the record of his service here(1869-1878) that are presented in this Special Publication. In 1878, Rev. Martz left Womelsdorf and accepted a call in

Tremont, Schuylkill County, PA, where he remained until 1880. He then "retired" from the ministry for a short time and was engaged in business at Lebanon, PA. While in "retirement" he served as temporary pastor(1882-83) to churches in eastern Dauphin County, PA, at Union Deposit, Sandy Hollow and Sand Hill. From here he moved to Piedmont, West Virginia, where he

served as pastor from 1885-1888. Rev. Martz then came back to Lebanon for a short time. He then moved to Northampton County, PA, in 1891/92, to minister to churches in Lyons, Macungie, Salem, Pleasantville and Mohrsville. He again returned to Lebanon until 1893/94, when he accepted a call in Walhalla, South Carolina. He died in South Carolina in 1898.
