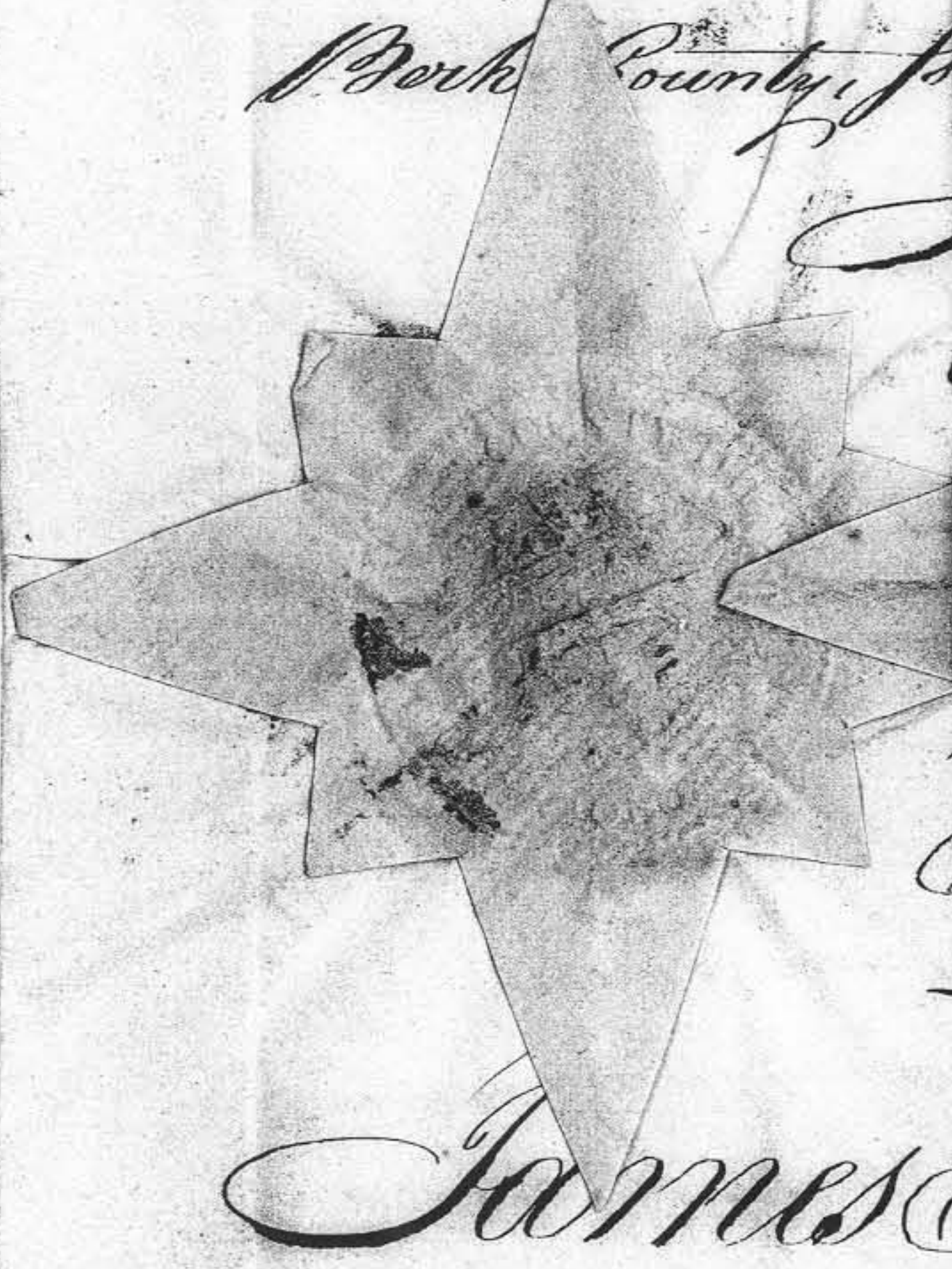

to an Act of Congress passed the fourteenth day of April Anno Domini one
thousand eight hundred and two A.D.: He the said James Moore
after having sworn to support the Constitution of the United States, and
having first duly complied with the several other provisions and conditions
contained and required in such case in and by the said Act of Congress
was thereupon by order of said Court admitted a Citizen of the United
States accordingly.
