HUSBAND NOTES: Rudolph HOCH

General: Rudolph Hoch, his wife Veronica and sons, John and Samuel, came to Philadelphia in 1717, from Switzerland. They were of Mennonite faith and as such they probably came to Penn's "holy experiment", to escape harassment and persecution in Europe. They settled first at Swedeland on the "Skoolkill", near present day Pottstown. The family later moved with son Johannes when he obtained a 220 acre tract of land, north of Friedensburg (Now Oley) in 1725. This was one of the first tracts of land issued by William Penn. The Hoch Homestead in 2007 remains in the Hoch family.

Initial source for this info has a marriage to Veronica in 1717; which of course would mean Veronica is a second wife. There is also thought to be a daughter Mary, about which nothing is known. And I have a Sybilla Hoch from the Rothermel book, who married Johann Peter Rothermel, she was born circa 1715. I would think she belongs to this family.

Balthaser Hoch baptised Oct. 22, 1651 Liestal, Basel, Switzerland and Elizabeth Gass parents of Balthaser Hoch are Hans Hoch baptised Sept. 4, 1625 and Barbara Ritter. Parents of Hans Hoch are George Hoch born circa 1587, married June 23, 1607 to Maria Gass.

CHILD NOTES: Samuel HOCH

General: Samuel started farming on part of his 400 acre tract, about two miles south of Oley. The Hochs were Moravians and they help establish the Oley Moravian Church on John's farm. John had donated 32 acres to the Moravian Church. The first log church was built in 1740. Also on Samuel's farm is the Sacred Oak Tree, which is recorded to be the site of sacred indian meetings. Samuel wrote a will in 1762, naming Daniel Hoch and Jacob Schneider as executors. Which of course is a date in conflict with death date I have. No records but probably buried in Hoch-Bauman Private Cemetery.

CHILD NOTES: Johannes HOCH

General: Johannes purchased his farm from William Remberry, a 220 acre tract in Oley Township. Deed is dated January 30, 1728. That same year his mother died and a small plot, 80 x 80 was set aside on the homestead. The private cemetery contains six generations of Hochs and is known today as Hoch private cemetery #1. Location is approximately 50 yards northwest of crossing of Bertolet Mill Road and Hoch Road in Oley Township, PA. Johannes first built a log house on his land and it was said this structure was used by the community as a stronghold during Indian raids. It was destroyed by fire in 1868, when it was being used as a tool shed for the farm. Present stone house on homestead was built by Johannes' son Abraham in 1788. An addition was added in 1811 and remodelling in 1889.

Johannes received a land warrant for 50 acres on March 31, 1733, somewhere. He purchased a 266 acre tract in Richmond Township in 1741, which he later sold to his son Daniel. He sold some land in Oley Township to his son in law, Jacob Keim, in 1753. He erected a mill in 1761 in Oley Township, and that same year sold some Oley land to his son Johannes. He also purchased some land in Maiden creek Township, which he later sold to his son Jacob. In 1761 Johannes was recorded with 300 acres. With his will he did grant and devise unto son Abraham, 220 acres.

CHILD NOTES: Sybilla HOCH

General: Probable daughter of Rudolph Hoch. Nobody else has linked her to Rudolph; but she has the name, the age and in the right place.

HUSBAND NOTES: David KAUFFMAN

General: The House of Oley, Kauffman book says the father is unknown. Frederick Balthaser's 1924 History of Berks County, says David is the son of Johann Kauffman, born 1680 in Strasburg, Germany, and Anne. And again the former book is not sure where David was buried, possibly in Germantown with his mother and brother, or at the family plot in Oley Township. Balthaser says in Oley Township. David arrived in America before 1716, with his mother and brother Jacob. Jacob received the Kaufman home in Germantown from mother

Anne. David bought 200 acres of land in the Oley Valley from a Herbein, transaction was dated 28 November 1727. He purchased from the Penn's, or received land patents for additional land, 100 acres in 1733, and another 54 acres in 1740. He also owned 175 acres in Maidencreek Township. A Leshner source has his death in January 1762. He is considered one of the early Oley Valley pioneers. Upon his death, son Jacob received the Oley Valley homestead of 300 acres and son Johannes took the 175 acres in Maidencreek Township. The original Kauffman homestead survives today at 125 acres and still owned by a family member.

CHILD NOTES: Jacob Hoch KAUFFMAN

General: Jacob was a veteran of the Revolutionary War. He obtained the family homestead in 1763 by purchasing it from other heirs. He wrote his will on 29 September 1804, and it was probated 19 November 1804. Jacob Griesemer Sr., Jacob Griesemer Jr., and Philip DeTurk Jr. were witnesses. His estate of 354 acres went to his son Jacob for 3000 pounds.

HUSBAND NOTES: Johann Georg HAIN

General: Married at Alpenrod, Palatinate. Emmigrated into New York in 1709 and later followed many into Tulpehocken Region. His will was dated 8 April 1746. Mentions children Anna Sibilla, Elizabeth, John Christ, Peter, John George, John Adam, John Frederick, John Henry, John Casper, and his wife Verontica.

According to Glatfelter's 'Pastors and People and their Congregations' book, Vol 1, pub 1980: The Hain's church was first organized in the later 1730s. Henry Goetschy served from c1738-1740. The register for the Congregation in Heidelberg was begun on 4/26/1746 probably by Casimir Miller who served 1745-1750. After him was Philip Michael 1750-1751, Henry Decker 1752-1756, John Waldschmidt 1757-1770, and even William Boos 1771-1789, and 1792-1805, Conran Ammann 1789-1792.

On 1Dec 1752 Georg 'Hean' deeded 4 acres in Heidelberg township to John Eaker, Paul Lengle, Peter Ruth and Casper Hean, trustees, and the tract already contained a house of worship of the Reformed Congregation with a burial ground enclosed. Berks Deed A-3 p 25. Originally a log church, a stone church was erected in 1766. Much remodeled, it still stands, said Glatfelter. He further states that Rev. Muhlenberg wrote in 1771 that it was on a hill, finely laid out, with a tower rising above the surrounding forest. He called it 'Haehn's' Church. Glatfelter says also that some of the early records of the congregation were recorded in the 'Publications of the Genealogical Society of Pennsylvania 5 '(1912) p 53-109. He also cites 'History of St John's (Hain's) Reformed church' by W. J. Kershner and Adam G. Lerch pub 1916.

In Knittle's book on the Palatines in the NY camps he shows a Johan Jurg HAAN with wife and 7 children on the 6th ship which sailed 28 July 1709.

WIFE NOTES: Veronica KOCH

General: Letter of administration of the Estate of Fronica Hains, widow, Heidelberg Township, issued 16 July 1756 to Peter Hains, 2nd son.

CHILD NOTES: Anna Sibilla HAIN

General: Born at Ulster, NY. Married Jacob FREYMEYER, had at least a son Michael. Son Michael married a Maria Sabina ??, and had 9 children. Michael died c1777 in Robeson Twp., and his widow remarried Henry NEUKIRCH and by late 1780s or early 1790, they located to Washington Co., MD near Hagerstown where they died. It is probable that Jacob FREYMEYER, who died c1778 in Heidelberg, was a son of Michael FREYMEYER, who was in the Schoharie camps in NY State and had sailed on the 5th ship 7/15/1709 with wife and 5 children. He was also shown in the Simmendinger Register in 1717 with wife Anna Elisabeth and 6 children living in Weiserdorf or Neu Stuttgardt camp in NY.

Jacob FREYMEYER's estate distribution dated 6 April 1779. Widow received 1/3 share totaling 319 pounds. Christian oldest son received two shares 127 pounds.

Remaining children each received one share of 63 pounds. Michael, William, John, Henry, Elisabeth, Margaret, Mary Elizabeth, and Eva. Total value of estate was 957 pounds. This was certified by Henry Christ, Orphan's Court, that it was paid, and witnessed by Daniel Levan, Esq, Jacob Shoemaker and John Ludwig.
