with prayer. Dr. Wm Moore of Womelsdorf
was examined for admission to the church
and his examination was sustained."
"on Sabbath morning
Sept 29th 1839 the communion of the
Lords Supper was administered by
Rev Wm W Taylor when Dr Wm Moore
was admitted in examination.
